335 MINUTES

RESOLVED

336 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The Town Clerk submitted a Financial Statement giving details of income and expenditure against budget for the period to 11th August, 2010. He also submitted details of the balances on all of the Town Council's accounts as at 11th August, 2010 totalling £174,891; the Town Council had 'ring fenced'£84,805 of this total for specific projects.

337 ANNUAL AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS

The Town Clerk reported that the external audit of the Town Council accounts for the year ended 31st March 2010 had been successfully completed and that there were no issues arising from the audit report. The statutory notice that the audit had been completed together with copies of sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Annual Return had been displayed on the Town Council notice board for the required fourteen day period.

Towards repairs to their building.

c). I.W. Musical Competition Festival.

Assistance with the costs of the 2011 festival.

b). I.W. Musical Competition Festival	£ 50
