### 393 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Birch, McGregor, Peacey-Wilcox and Wilcox.

### 394 MINUTES

### **RESOLVED**

That the Minutes of the Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2012 be taken as read, approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

### 395 FINANCIAL STATEMENT AND NOTICE OF AUDIT

The Town Clerk submitted details of expenditure against budget up to the end of the 2011/12 financial year and details of the balances on the Town Council's accounts. The Town Clerk explained that the year end balances totalled £99,410 although the Town Council had 'ring fenced' expenditure of £72,969 leaving a useable balance of only £26,441.

The final accounts for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012 and the Return for the Annual Audit were being prepared by Bright Brown Chartered Accountants; the Annual Return had to be submitted by 11<sup>th</sup> June 2012 and all of the necessary statutory notices to comply with the audit requirements had been posted on the Town Council notice board at the appropriate times.

### 396 APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT

The Town Clerk reported that £5,500 had been allocated in the budget to enable small grants to be made to local organisations; the following applications for grant had been received which included copies of each organisations latest sets of accounts.

### a) Cowes Carnival Committee

To assist with insurance costs, new tyres for the carnival float and for the Queen of Queens event.

# b). Cowes Open Bowls Tournament Committee

To assist in the running of the 58<sup>th</sup> Cowes Open Bowls tournament held during AAM Cowes Week.

## c). Gurnard Pre School

To assist with building works and other general resources following the re-location of the school to a new site in Baring Road.

### **RECOMMENDED**

1). That grants be made to the following organisations in accordance with the amounts shown:

a). Cowes Carnival Committee £2,000 b). Cowes Open Bowls Tournament Committee £ 400 c). Gurnard Pre School £ 500

2). That the balance in the budget of £2,600 be kept in reserve pending further applications which may be received.

(Councillor Banks declared a personal interest in a) above as he had donated materials for the carnival float and Councillor Wells as he had been asked to be a judge at the Queen of Queens event.) (Councillor Banks declared a personal and prejudicial interest in c) above as his daughter had submitted the application and he left the meeting at 7.05p.m.)
