## 438 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Jones and Wells.

# 439 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor Banks declared a personal and prejudicial interest in the item on the ORP Blyskawiica commemoration as he was the Co Vice President of the organisation and Councillor Walters declared a personal interest as he was the organisations auditor.

Councillor Banks declared a personal interest in the grant applications from Cowes Week Ltd. as he was the Town Council representative to their Shoreside Committee.

## 440 MINUTES

## RESOLVED

That the Minutes of the Meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2013 be taken as read, approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

## 441 BANK ACCOUNTS

Councillor Walters referred to the Town Council's decision to maintain accounts with Lloyds Bank; it was agreed that the Town Clerk was authorised to transfer funds between all appropriate accounts within Lloyds Bank.

# 442 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The Chairman submitted a Financial Statement giving details of expenditure against budget for the period to date. A total of  $\pounds$ 71,638 of the  $\pounds$ 95,100 budget had been spent and it was projected that this figure would rise to  $\pounds$ 82,901 by year end.

# 443 PREPARATION OF ACCOUNTS

The Town Clerk requested authority to invite Bright Brown, Chartered Accountants to undertake the preparation of the final accounts for the financial year 2012/13.

#### RECOMMENDED

That Bright Brown, Chartered Accountants be appointed to undertake the preparation of the Town Council's accounts for the financial year 2012/13.

## 443 ORP BLYSKAWICA COMMEMMORATION

The Town Clerk submitted a letter from the ORP Blyskawica Society requesting the release of funding following the 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary commemoration of the defence of Cowes by the ORP Blyskawica; a financial appraisal was also included which showed that expenditure on the event exceeded income by  $\pounds 5,118.98$ .

The Town Clerk reminded members that at the January 2012 Town Council meeting it was agreed to underwrite the commemoration in the sum of £3,000.

#### RECOMMENDED

That the Town Clerk be authorised to pay £3,000 to the Friends of the ORP Blyskawica Society.

## 444 APPLICATIONS FOR GRANTS

The Town Council had been asked to consider the following funding requests:

- a) Cowes Week Ltd. towards the cost of staging the traditional end of AAM Cowes Week firework display.
- b) Cowes Week Ltd. towards a 2013 AAM Cowes Week Red Arrows display.
- c) Jubilee Sailing Trust towards the ongoing running costs of the organisation.
- d) Cowes Carnival Committee towards costs associated with the 2013 season of carnival events.

## RECOMMENDED

1). That a sum of £500 from the 2013/14 budget be gifted to the AAM Cowes Week Fireworks Committee;

2). That no grant be made in respect of funding towards the 2013 AAM Cowes Week Red Arrows display;

3). That no grant be made to the Jubilee Sailing Trust; and

4). That on production of proof of expenditure, a sum of up to  $\pm 1,500$  from the 2013/14 budget be awarded to the Cowes Carnival Committee towards their insurance and licence costs.
