- P/01022/14 Single storey extension to porch on front elevation to provide entrance to flat; proposed balcony on rear elevation, 33 Castle Road
- P/01065/14 Alterations; proposed balconies on front elevation at first and second floor levels, 5 Marine View Close
- P/01029/14 Increase height of roof to provide accommodation within roof space; dormer window on south elevation, 244 Arctic Road
- P/01093/14 Demolition of carport; proposed single storey extension on front elevation to form additional living accommodation; new carport, 4 Mornington Road
- P/01131/14 Proposed extension at first floor level to provide additional living accommodation to include juliet balcony on rear elevation, 3 Ward Avenue
- P/01114/14 Replacement of rear wall of existing extension and new roof to include roof lantern, 34 York Street
