- P/01010/14 Replacement of wooden entrance doors with glass entrance doors on north elevation, Holy Trinity Church, Trinity Church Lane
- P/01011/14 LBC for replacement of wooden entrance doors with glass entrance doors on north elevation, Holy Trinity Church, Trinity Church Lane
