7843 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

7844 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillors Brown & Taylor declared a non-pecuniary interest in matters relating to Crossfield Avenue as residents of Crossfield Avenue. Councillor Oliver declared a non-pecuniary interest in matters relating to Park Road as a resident of Park Road.

7845 NETWORK INTEGRITY REGISTER / PRIORITY SCHEMES FOR COWES

Councillors discussed a number of requests for amendments to the highways network in the Cowes area. The IW Council have requested that the Town Council identify 5 priority schemes for the Cowes area with the deadline for a reply of 30 November 2018. It was:

RESOLVED

That the priority schemes for the Cowes area, in no particular order, are:

- A review of the speed limit past The Range / to place a pedestrian refuge access from the bus stop into The Range car park / request for a new bus shelter in Three Gates Road.
- To resolve parking problems in Tennyson Road, Stanley Road and Fraser Close.
- To mark out the bus stop in Park Road opposite the Isle of Wight Community Club entrance.
- Provision of dropped kerbs to the disabled bays in Queens Road.
- Change the 'Give Way' sign to a 'Stop' sign and extend the double yellow lines on the south western side of the junction of Mill Hill Road and Victoria Road.
- Provide funding for a Road Crossing Patrol person at the crossing point in Park Road.
- Place a single yellow line along Baring Road from the Ward Avenue junction to the Castle Hill junction.
