488 FINANCIAL STATEMENT AS AT 31 MARCH 2020

The Town Clerk submitted a financial statement for the year 2019 / 2020 giving details of income and expenditure. Councillors discussed each budget heading and the ring fenced and ear marked balances carried forward to 2020 / 2021. The balances in the Town Council's bank accounts and petty cash as at 31 March 2020 were £356,674.27 of which £167,048.29 is ring fenced / ear marked expenditure. The Reserves as at 31 March 2020 were £189,625.98 which represents around seven months operating costs. It was:
