
Message from the Mayor of Cowes

Isle of Wight Council helpline and other local support

The COVID-19 helpline remains open for anyone that needs additional support, seven days a week.

Call (01983) 823600 between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday, and between 10am and 3pm at weekends for support. You can also email <u>contact.centre@iow.gov.uk</u>.

This helpline is for anyone who needs help because of self-isolation, who is alone with no local network of friends, family or neighbours and needs support, or who feels vulnerable and may need assistance with:

- help to access pharmacy medication delivery services and healthcare needs;
- access to online shopping delivery services or small essential shopping requests;
- signposting to partner agencies for support with issues arising from isolation including welfare, finance, mental health, childcare issues, crisis advice and support or other caring responsibilities.

The IW Council has also committed extra money to the 'Help Through Crisis' scheme which is already operating on the Island to provide crucial help to those Islanders struggling to afford food and other essentials during the pandemic.



Accessing dental care

Dental Practices are open, however practices will need

to prioritise patients with the most urgent need.

Please do not visit your dental practice unless you've been advised to. This will ensure the practice can continue to provide essential care safely.

The Finance, Acquisitions and Staffing Committee have considered a draft budget and have recommended <u>no increase</u> in the precept for the 2021/22 financial year. The final decision will be made at the Town Council meeting on 10 December 2020.

Planning and Licensing Committee Report

The function of this committee is to inspect planning and licencing applications, advising the appropriate departments of the IW Council whether we support an application or oppose them. We can only oppose planning applications following national planning guidance, although we can suggest areas of concern. If the application is acceptable there is no need for comment. We will sometimes express support for applications which we feel benefits the town; a recent example is Spinlock's plans to develop the former Police Station.

While other committees make recommendations to be ratified at a full Town Council meeting, the Planning and Licencing Committee has delegated powers to make decisions.

The Committee's role is purely advisory, the final decision is made by the IW Council.

Free Parking for Mainland NHS Patients



There are limited parking permits available for free parking in Northwood House Car Park for Island residents attending NHS mainland hospital appointments. The scheme has been extended by Northwood House Charitable Trust Co. Ltd. currently until the end of December 2020. Our thanks to Northwood House for continuing the scheme to assist patients travelling to the mainland for treatment.

Christmas Church Services

Current information from Reverend Poppe regarding services over the festive period at St Mary's and Holy Trinity Churches:

Holy Trinity is planning a carol service to be streamed on 13 December at 11:15am.

St Mary's is planning a streamed 9 lessons and carols by candlelight (probably to go out on 22 December at 4pm – usual time for the annual service). Sadly with no congregation as singing is still banned.

We hope to do a Midnight service on Christmas Eve. This will probably be a streamed service as we will have different people in the Church less than 72 hours later.

There will be a 9:30am Christmas Day service in Holy Trinity. Limited to 50 people and no congregational singing, though I hope to have a small Choir. There will be an 11am Christmas Day service in St Mary's. Limited to 50 people and no congregational singing, though I hope to have a small Choir. Christmas Day services are expected to be ticketed as a result of such limited numbers. These services will also be live streamed. There will be further instructions from the Church nearer the time.
