Former Mayor of Cowes unveils memorial to commemorate victims of the COVID-19 pandemic.

A new memorial, commissioned by Cowes Town Council, was unveiled by former Mayor of Cowes, Councillor Lora Peacey Wilcox on Monday 4 September 2023. The memorial was suggested by Councillor Peacey Wilcox during her term of office as Mayor of Cowes [2019-2021], and supported by members of Cowes Town Council.

Comprising of a granite stone, inscribed with the words "REMEMBERING ALL THOSE WHO LOST THEIR LIVES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC", the memorial has been positioned within the Rosebed at the Park Road entrance to Northwood Park. The location was chosen to be visible to passers-by, whilst also providing a quiet place to sit, reflect and remember loved ones lost.

The memorial is accompanied by an oak plaque commissioned by the Town Council, crafted by local craftsman Dovetailed Design.

## Councillor Peacey Wilcox said:

"I felt it was important to remember so many lives lost to us here in Cowes during that time. It was heart-breaking in the extreme with what families were going through.

Out of the depths of despair and sorrow comes hope and new life.

I thank all of those that supported my request at the Town Council to allow this memorial to be

commissioned. It was lovely to see a stone from the London Memorial Wall, who I have been working closely with.

Finally, thanks to Wight Stonemasonry and the team that fitted the very large memorial in a quite challenging area.
