Please can I request Cowes Town Council's support facilitating 'Private Road, No Parking' signage at the Battery Road/ Brambles Lane junction with Baring Road?

To note whilst the school is in Gurnard, Brambles Lane and Battery Road is within Cowes. Below, I have added a photo showing some of the anti-social parking that impacts upon local residents.

In summary:

1. This was requested, as a condition of the recent planning application for Gurnard School.
2. Children's Services (see below) has offered to fund any works.
3. Rights of Way has also funded and provided suitable signage in Cow Lane, which is overseen by the IW Council
4. Gurnard Parish Council has allocated £4k to fund a school crossing patrol for the coming year.
