**CONSTABULARY**



Please be aware of the traffic regulations for the pedestrianised area of Cowes town.

- No vehicles except bicycles being pushed in the precinct between the hours of 10am through until 7am the next day, except for agreed exemptions.
- Between the hours of 7am to 10am vehicles can travel through the pedestrian precinct and this includes riding a bicycle, be aware that the pedestrian area is a one-way route for all vehicles.
- You can drive or ride through the pedestrian precinct if you are going to access an off-street premise, such as shop or residence and that property has off-street parking.
- You cannot ride a bicycle through the pedestrian precinct; a bicycle must be pushed unless it's between 7am and 10am and only in the direction of the one-way system.



Cowes Pedestrian precincts with the one-way system are as follows.

Starting at the junction of Market Hill heading towards the junction of The Arcade (entrance to Red Funnel).

Starting at the junction of Carvel Lane and High Street (outside of Costa) to the junction of Shooters Hill and Birmingham Road.

The No Entry sign at Shooters Hill, this applies to all vehicles including bicycles.
