Cowes Police Monthly Neighbourhood Policing Report

As a team the neighbourhood officers are educating and enforcing the cycling restrictions through Cowes, this is ongoing and interaction with cyclists and the passing of the information leaflet will be ongoing.

Police are aware of the camera on Shooters Hill and await data giving more accurate timings to allow for targeting.

Throughout the summer there have been numerous reports of antisocial behaviour, mostly along the shoreline from Gurnard through to the parade and involving youths. We will as a team follow up on each of the ASB reports, making contact with the reporting person, and attending the locations. There has been engagement with youths at the locations, most of the time the groups have been willing to heed advice of the officers, this has been centred on water safety and preventing injury with good partnership working with the Cowes Harbour Commission.

Cowes week was extremely busy, I am yet to see any statistics but the sheer volume of people on the street in the evenings kept the team in constant work.

There is a list of times and dates in which both Police officers and Police community support officers will hold beat surgeries and have the police station open. The details are available to the public online.

Prior reports of ASB in and around the Moorgreen area have lessened through engagement with persons located in that area. Less noise and less litter, no recent reports made.

The team are aware of the recent nuisance and damage reports relating to the public conveniences.

I have attended the council office in Northwood house and spoken about actions that could be considered.

If persons are known to be causing antisocial behaviour in Council owned facilities, will the council consider drawing up a document that could be served on identified persons informing that they could be banned from entering Cowes Town Council premises?
